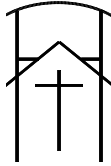

Time Out ... though our regular Sunday groups are taking a break, 'Time Out' is available instead on Sundays hopefully throughout the holiday period. It's for 3-11's and meets in St Andrew's Parish Room after the first 15 minutes of each Sunday morning's service (although on 7th August there is an all age service in St Andrew's instead). There will also be a United All Age service on 11th September in St Andrew's, which will include the re-dedication of leaders. Our regular Sunday groups for 3-6's, 7-10's & 11-14's will resume on 18th September.

St Andrew's PCC... i) As part of the aspiration in our new Mission Action Plan to play a greater role in meeting social need in our area, the PCC has got some way to agreeing one project... more details of this will follow in the Autumn. We also decided to use this notice sheet to ask whether any members of the congregation had a vision for another project of this kind, that they would consider taking the lead with. If you have any thoughts on this front, please do talk to Andrew.

ii) With the Chorltons back in the UK. The PCC is considering different routes for finding new overseas mission partners to link with in the coming years. One possible link is with Kieran and Ashley McKnight. After several years of Kieran working as a church youth worker in Stone, they are moving in September to work with a church in the United Arab Emirates. We are looking forward to hearing them both speak about this new challenge at this morning's services.
