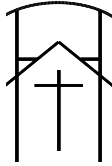

December Day One - "Church-Aid" ... Andrew will be speaking briefly on 2 Corinthians 8:1-15 and Becky Loo will be sharing about how she has set up "Catch the Dream Community" to help the people in the village of Lungi in Sierra Leone.

St Andrew's 10.30 am Services ... The PCC last month agreed to test the waters of using the screen for hymn words and liturgy.
