Celebrating 80 Years of Worship in the Westlands ... next week's United Partnership Anniversary Service marks the 45th anniversary of our Local Ecumenical Partnership and also (within a few weeks) the 80th anniversary of both St Andrew's and St Peter's.

Shallowford Bible Day ... Friday, 8th June from 10.00 am – 4.00 pm. We are joining with other churches in sponsoring a day of Bible teaching and guided reflection. This year will be looking at the book of Nehemiah with the title 'Restoring the Vision', led by Steve Brady, Principal of Moorlands Bible College and a regular speaker at the Keswick Convention. Identity Course ... *Who is God? Can I make contact with Him? Who are we? What is the purpose of life?* We have run this course several times over the last few years and are hoping to be able to start a new group shortly. Each week includes a discussion starter on DVD, with opportunity for interaction and questions. Ideal for anyone wanting to know more about the Christian faith, or looking for a refresher course. It also forms the main part of the preparation course for adults who would like to think about being confirmed in a future year. More details from the Vicar.

Christian Aid Week: 13th – 20th May ... theme: 'God's Kingdom is stronger than storms'. We are very grateful to those who have been collecting regularly over the years. We are also mindful that some people would be quite happy to deliver envelopes but not to collect and we tried this on an experimental basis last year. A note is delivered with each envelope - encouraging people to give either by donating online or placing a cheque (but can be money) in the envelope and putting it through the door of one of our two homes. We would like to extend this scheme this year so that all streets are covered by some means and it would also be good to have some more drop-off points so that individuals don't have to travel too far to deliver their envelope. Catch the Dream ... Becky Loo would like to thank everyone who supported the launch party event and who generously donated to help the villagers in Sierra Leone rebuild their lives after Ebola. Over £1,500 was raised which shall enable the farmers to replant this year and continue to build their ability to meet their own food needs. Our next steps shall be to apply for grants to

help provide them with training to improve their yield and increase the number of harvests in the year. We are planning another *Catch the Dream Party* later in the year, so look out for details of another fun night.
