**St Andrew's Annual Meeting** ... The annual meeting will be held in the church hall at 6.30 pm on Sunday, 14<sup>th</sup> April. We need to elect 15 members of the PCC (Parochial Church Council) for 2018-19, and there is a nomination form at the back of church for those who are willing to stand. We also need to elect two church wardens to serve for the next 12 months, and are grateful to Helen Dodds for her willingness to continue in this role, and for Helen Collins for being willing to stand, but others can be nominated too. **Ecumenical Prayer Vigil at Stoke Minster today, Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> March ...** since the Friday following the ecumenical event is the originally planned 'Brexit Day,' a 12-hour prayer vigil will take place at Stoke Minster from 12 noon until 12 midnight today, Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> March. The vigil will take various forms during the 12 hours, with periods of corporate prayer, led prayer and silence. Prayer topics will include business, education, health, the community and Europe. Anglicans, Methodists, Roman Catholics and Pentecostals (so far) have agreed to take responsibility for different sections of the vigil. People will be free to arrive when they are able and to leave as they need. Drinks will be available at the back of the Minster throughout and there are toilet facilities on site. As part of this there will be an ecumenical service at 6.30 pm, attended by most of the main denominational leaders in the area. All welcome.
