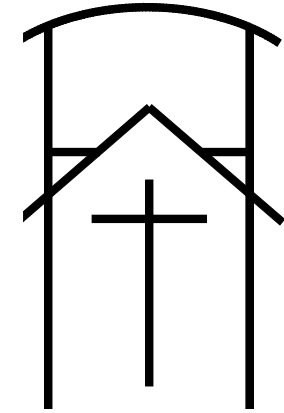

As you'll probably know, keep calm and carry on was originally the slogan on a ministry of information world war two poster. In the last 10 years or so, it has re-appeared on many different items, both in the original version and in 101 variants.

One of these 'keep calm and pray' could be seen, at least in part, as reflecting what has long been a favourite bible verse for many believers

Don't worry about anything, but in all your prayers ask God for what you need, always asking him with a thankful heart .(Philippians 4 verse 6)

To some, simply to be told 'don't worry', or 'keep calm' may appear to be no help at all. But the value here is in being given something else to do with our anxieties, to turn them into prayer to God. We're not promised an instant answer to all our troubles. But the Christian believer is assured that we will know at least something of god's peace amidst our difficulties and stresses

Share a hot drink and a biscuit with others who have been bereaved, in St Andrew's parish room (enter through small door at back of church car park), every third Friday of the month.



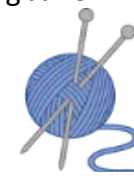
Hall Hire
