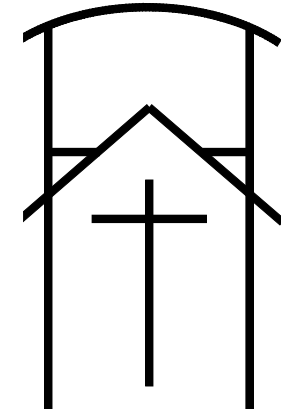

During my years of ministry in South Warwickshire sheep grazing out in the fields were a very familiar sight.

However, I can't recall ever seeing a shepherd! In the time of Jesus shepherds were a common sight in the fields and on the hillsides.

The shepherd knew his sheep...and the sheep knew the shepherd; they knew his voice and they followed him.

When the shepherd wanted to move his flock to pastures new, he called them.
