Is there anybody out there?

This month sees the 50th anniversary of the first person to walk on the moon; and there are now regular suggestions that manned flights might again be attempted – and not only to the moon, but even to one or two of the planets.

In the 1960's there was quite a lot of comment about the significance of space travel on issues of faith. Kruschov, the Soviet leader, saw the fact that Gagarin hadn't seen God in his travels above the earth as proving the truth of atheism. But whilst some astronauts may have drawn that kind of conclusion, many others have found their faith strengthened. Indeed John Glenn once proclaimed from orbit: "To look out at this kind of creation and not believe in God is to me impossible."

Perhaps a few of the younger readers of this newsletter might one day venture into space and give their own opinion. For the rest of us, even though we may never travel into space, we may often find ourselves looking in awe at the night sky. And maybe too, with the writer of psalm 8, being inexorably drawn towards the idea of our world having a maker.

When I look at the sky, which you have made, at the moon and the stars, which you set in their places what are human beings, that you think of them; mere mortals, that you care for them? (Ps8v3,4)


