**St Andrew's New Hall Update** ... we are continuing to work with BDP (Building Design Partnership) on the plans. Although the architect we had been dealing with Graeme Renton has now retired, his supervisor, Architect Director Svetlana Solomona, came to meet us last week and is now taking direct control of the project. BDP anticipate making a planning application on our behalf at the end of January. Please do pray for their staff who are working on this for us, and for a successful outcome. An increasingly large majority of the PCC are convinced that the provision of updated and attractive facilities will be a valuable asset to our mission, to the

welcome we are able to give people, and in enabling us to serve our local community by offering a great space for local groups to use.

Our new architect has advised us to invite opinions on our proposals from all members of the local community, and there will be a drop in session on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> January, 7.00 pm – 8.00 pm in the Parish Room.
