Question

Bible Story

The Good Samaritan from Luke 10:25-37 Read the story from the Bible or look it up and watch it online

Questions to choose from and chat about after the story...

- What happened to the person walking along the road in the parable Jesus told?
- Why do you think the first two people walked past?
- Why did the hurt person think that the Samaritan (orange) wouldn't stop and help him?
- How did he show kindness to the hurt person on the road?
- How can we show kindness to others?
- Is there anyone that you would find it hard to show kindness to? Why?
- How can Jesus help us be kind to all, whoever they are?

Question for adults to answer with their children

When did God bring good out of a difficult situation?

(It really helps your children to grow in their faith when you share how God works in your life too, and how you follow him in the good times and bad, so go for it!)

Prayer

Draw faces on fruit and as you peel or cut the fruit, chat to God about the difficult things that are happening at the moment. Then as you eat and enjoy the fruit thank God for his kindness and love for us and ask him how you can be kind to others

Crafts and Challenges

- Retell the story with fruit people or teddies or actors (although don't actually beat each other up!)
- Make a helping hands chart (see below) and add your own ideas for your family. You could use stickers for points and give little prizes at the end of the day/week
- Make a fruit salad together thanking God for all the good things he has given to us as you put the different fruit in the bowl
